TRAINING TO BE OFFERED

The AARP Smart Driver™ Training is scheduled for Thursday, February 19, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. The cost is \$15 for AARP members and \$20 for non-members. Many automobile insurance carriers provide discounts to those completing the training. Participants will receive a course completion certificate which is valid for three years. AARP instructor, Steve Flowers, will conduct the class.

DIABETES TOTAL WELLNESS SERIES SLATED

More than 1,000,000 adults and children in Georgia suffer from diabetes. We are very excited to partner with East Georgia Healthcare, Emanuel Medical Center, Emanuel Partnership for Health, UGA Extension, and WellCare Health Plans to provide an insightful series focusing on diabetes management. Four free sessions are scheduled throughout 2015. Individuals attending three of the four sessions will receive a free diabetes screening. Lunch will be provided, as well as cooking demonstrations.
