- 1. MSA to reject the proposed Summer Pay Policy proposal and to send it back to APC for revision in order to consider special circumstances like physical education activity classes, science labs, art foundations and studio classes.
- 2. MSA to accept the modified "7.5 Promotion and Tenure" policy as rewritten by Alan Brasher. Alan will draft a letter to the president in this regard.
- 3. MSA that the FS create an ad hoc committee charged with reviewing and commenting on EGSC's Academic Freedom Policy, and that the committee be composed of three faculty members, one from each academic division, that Reid Derr chair the committee, and that Dr. Armond Boudreaux serve as the Humanities member, and one member from Math-Science to be invited by FS.
- 4. MS to accept the "Proposal to eliminate COMPASS exit testing for Learning Support math."
